COVID rules

Entry to the Jazz Office and venues (other than the public area of Fiddlers Green), will require QR code log on (or via manual sign in), PLUS evidence of double vaccination or valid medical exemption for those 18 and older. For ease of access: - Download the Victorian Services app to your mobile phone (interstate visitors please note).

COVID rules contd.

Add your Covid-19 vaccination certificate from Medicare to your Victorian Services APP.

Mask wearing is mandatory in all indoor venues (unless otherwise shown). Also recommended in all situations where social distancing difficult. During 30 min. cleaning breaks grab some fresh air outside.

Badge Collecting

Badges and wristbands will not be issued to musicians or patrons without evidence of vaccination. (Therefore, all patrons/musicians must attend the Festival Office). No collecting for others.
